What better way will there be of interesting him in history, geography and languages and of making these subjects live for him instead of being only things in school books? If I pass my hobby on to him, he will bless me for it as I have blessed my mother for her wise action.

We can use in to describe what somebody is wearing	We use by + V-ing to describe how we do or did something.	We use without + V-ing to say that a particular action is not done or was not done
